MY SUPPORT LINK

Purpose Statement: To be an innovative web-based application for people with intellectual disabilities and their families to easily connect with one another, and to share resources and access: a) affordable and flexible supports, including creative living, respite/short break and inclusive community participation, b) qualified and reliable support workers, and c) social and educational information.



SELECT A BREAK

Purpose Statement: To develop and provide 'Right Fit Respite Options' that are affordable, flexible and reflect sensitivity to individual and family needs.



THE RIGHT SUPPORT IN MY HOME

Purpose Statement: To develop a full range of community residential support options which provide the right level of support to promote independence, self-determination, community involvement and contribution for adults with intellectual disabilities.

The Right Support in MY Home Pilot







Right Support developed a range of flexible options to provide the right support at the right time.

- **5** people have successfully moved from 24 hour small group living to a home of their own
- 2 complex young men transitioned from 24 hour Children's services to a home of their own using technology to enhance supports
- 3 people have moved to a new home to enhance selfdetermination – just in time support rather than just in case

Technology Compliments Support

- Direct support is enhanced with the use of technology
- Support when needed, not "just in case"
- Engages natural support networks
- Personal outcomes focused
- Ethical considerations for appropriate technology use





Ethical Use of Technology

- Simply because something is technically possible doesn't mean it will be considered
- The use of technology to compliment supports will be a personal choice and requires full consent of each person supported

Home Alone Assessment

- Assessment was developed to measure home alone skills
- Looks at a variety of different skills that are necessary to safely stay home alone
- Topics include:
 - How to stay safe at home
 - What to do in an emergency
 - Possible dangers in the home
 - Going out alone
 - Respecting boundaries when home alone





PPCO Discussion

- Pluses, Potentials, Concerns, Outcomes/Overcome Concerns
- PPCO tool takes a positive approach to idea evaluation










