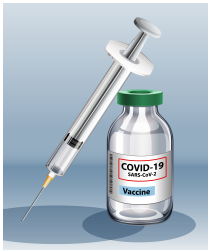

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I want to protect myself and the people around me from getting sick from Covid-19.



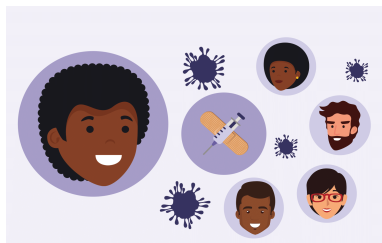
I will get a vaccine. A vaccine is a type of medicine that helps to make sure I am healthy.

We already get vaccines for other illnesses like the flu shot. Vaccines make your body stronger.



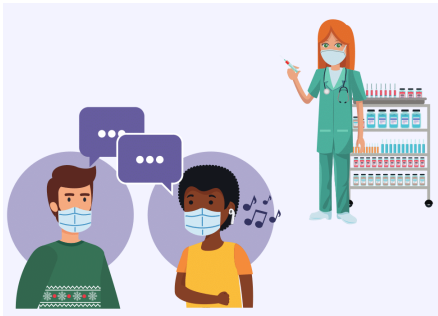
Doctors think less people will get sick with COVID-19 if more people have the vaccine.



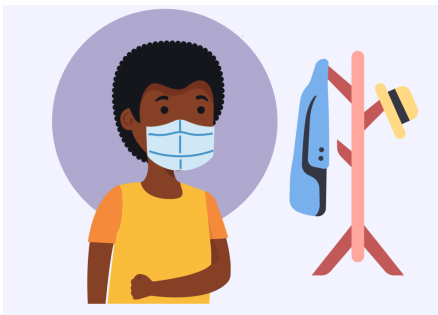
If I have questions about the vaccine, I can ask my staff, my family, or my doctor.
