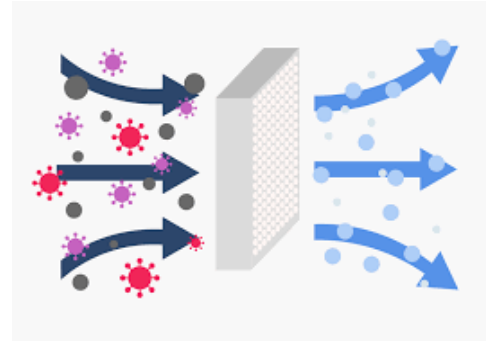


Air Quality: HEPA Filters

What is a HEPA filter?

- HEPA filters are air purification systems that can kill viruses and germs



Where should we put a HEPA filter?

- Place near the centre of the room or near potential sources of droplets/aerosols
- If your program site received multiple HEPA filters, place them in separate areas or levels of the home to maximize their use
- HEPA filters should be used in an individual's room when Aerosol-Generating Medical Procedures (AGMPs) are performed



How do we operate a HEPA filter?

- Plug in to wall outlet
- Choose level: the lowest level is appropriate for the size of our group homes
